CAMP INSTRUCTORS

Steve Gillispie Head Coach

Steve Gillispie, an experienced recruiter and instructor who has spent the past 11 seasons helping to build a powerhouse in the Ohio Valley Conference, is in his first season as the head baseball coach at Youngstown State University.



As Jacksonville State's hitting coach and recruiting coordinator, Gillispie helped lead the Gamecocks to nine 30-win seasons in an 11-year period. JSU went 152-79 in OVC games since joining the conference in 2004 and won the regular season or tournament title five times in nine seasons. Gillispie has also served as an assistant coach at Nebraska, Utah and UAB, and he was the Southeastern Area Scouting Supervisor for the Philadelphia Phillies for four years. He has 25 total years of baseball experience at the NCAA, Major League and junior college levels.

Kevin Smallcomb - Associate Head Coach

Kevin Smallcomb, who has recorded 445 victories as a college head coach, is the associate head coach at Youngstown State.

Smallcomb was the head coach at the University of Northern Colorado for eight years and the head coach at Mendocino College in California for 10 seasons. At Northern Colorado, he led the Bears to wins over five top-five ranked teams. He works primarily with YSU's hitters and infielders.

Jason Neal - Assistant Coach

Jason Neal, who spent the last three seasons as the recruiting coordinator at Morehead State University, is in his first season serving in the same capacity at YSU. Neal also coaches the Penguins' catchers and helps with the development of camps and clinics. He signed two Louisville Slugger All-Americans, 17 Kentucky East/West All-Stars and 24 All-State players during his tenure at Morehead State.

Jason Stanford - Assistant Coach

Former Cleveland Indians pitcher Jason Stanford is in his first year serving as YSU's pitching coach. Stanford pitched professionally for nine seasons with the Indians, Washington Nationals and Chicago Cubs organizations. He currently co-hosts Indians On-Deck, Indians Minor League Magazine and Tribe Report on SportsTime Ohio.

Craig Antush - Assistant Coach

Craig Antush is in his 14th year as a member of the YSU baseball coaching staff. During his tenure, Antush has helped develop six Penguin pitchers who were taken in the Major League Baseball Draft. Prior to his arrival at YSU, Antush was the head coach at Marshall from 1996-98 and served as pitching coach for the Thundering Herd for five seasons. Antush had a notable career as a player at the collegiate level as a relief pitcher for Alabama.

The Youngstown State Baseball "Holiday Camp" will take place over two days over holiday break at the Watson and Tressel Training Site on YSU's campus.
